

WOCTVET 2026: VIRTUAL POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

Dear Participant,

While we will miss seeing you in person at WOCTVET 2026, we are thrilled that you will be joining us virtually! To ensure your research gets the spotlight it deserves and is fairly evaluated by our judges, we require all virtual presenters to submit a pre-recorded video pitch of their poster.

Please review the following guidelines carefully to prepare and submit your video presentation.

1. Video Specifications

- **Duration:** Your video should be strictly between **3 to 5 minutes**.
- **Format:** Please submit your video in **MP4** format.
- **Resolution:** Minimum 720p (1080p is recommended for clarity).
- **Orientation:** Landscape (16:9 ratio).

2. Content & Recording Style

- **Screen Sharing:** We highly recommend using software like Zoom & Microsoft Teams to record your presentation. You should share your digital poster on the screen while keeping your webcam video visible in the corner.
- **The Pitch:** Treat this exactly like a live presentation. Introduce yourself, state your paper title, and walk the audience through your poster in a logical order (Introduction, Objectives, Methodology, Results, Conclusion).
- **Visibility:** Ensure your poster is fully visible on the screen. You may zoom in on specific sections (like charts or graphs) as you discuss them.
- **Audio Quality:** Ensure you are in a quiet room. Use a headset or a dedicated microphone if possible, so your voice is crisp and clear.
- **Lighting:** Make sure your face is well-lit. Sit facing a window or a light source so the audience can clearly see your expressions.
- **Pacing:** Speak clearly and at a steady pace. Since there is no live Q&A for virtual submissions, use your time effectively.

3. Submission Instructions

- **File Naming:** Please name your file using the following format: ID_FirstInitial_LastName.mp4 (e.g., 001_J_Doe.mp4).
- **How to Submit:** Upload your video file to a cloud storage service (<https://tinyurl.com/4ws4tdxr>) and generate a downloadable sharing link. Ensure the link permissions are set to **"Anyone with the link can view/download."**
- **Submission Deadline:** Please email your video link to (<https://tinyurl.com/4ws4tdxr>) no later than (20 September 2026). Late submissions will not be accepted.
